

## **PARISH CHARITIES**

Before 1982 a number of small charities dating from 1694 existed in the Parish. Each needed separate administration and the income from each charity was so small it was almost ineffective.

In 1982 the Charity Commission combined some of these charities. One of these is the

### **WELTON AND MELTON UNITED CHARITIES**

The aim of which is “ **to assist individuals resident in the Parish who are in conditions of need, hardship or disasters**”.

Another charity is the

### **WHITE BREAD CHARITY**

The aim of which is “ **to promote the education of persons under the age of 25 who are resident in the area**”.

Income from these two charities is low—some £330 in 2014/2015. Each year small grants are made to individuals, either direct or through Social Services, and to schools.

The two charities are administered by a small group of Trustees. Any request for help is treated confidentially and is carefully considered. Information is often obtained from a range of sources including , e.g., Social Services, schools or the Church.
